

SCHEDULE FOR REMITTANCE OF FEES

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF ANNAI FATHIMA COLLEGE

All Students are required to adhere to the following rules and regulations:

- 1) Punctuality, Discipline and Academic Excellence are the top priorities in the campus.
- 2) College will function from Monday to Saturday (Except Second and Final Saturdays of every month).
- 3) Students are expected to be inside the campus as instructed by their class teachers for the irrespective sessions.
- 4) The College Anthem and Tamil Thai Vazhthu will be played daily. Students are expected to stand and respect the prayer songs.

- 5) Students are expected to be in their respective classroom / practical lab 10 minutes before the stipulated time. Late comers will not be entertained.
- 6) Guests from to prated industries and hotels will visit our college very often and hence students are expected to maintain a perfect decorum and decency in the campus.
- 7) As English is the official language of communication in the college premises, Students are advised to use English as their mode of communication either with their classmates or with teachers.
- 8) Regular practice of hearing and speaking, alone can make one to master the language. This will be closely monitored by the faculty members.
- 9) On seeing some one on the corridor or any public place, student should greet him/her according to the time of the day with a pleasant smile.
- 10) The student should always carry the Identity card & present it, when it is demanded.
- 11) It is imperative that students should be present on the day of opening and closing of each term.
- 12) No Student is allowed to avail leave without prior permission. Permission should be obtained from the Principal of the College after obtaining HOD and Classtutor's signature. Sub sequent request for extension of leave will not be entertained. A fine of Rs. 50/- per day will be imposed in such cases. When the students come back, they must bring leave letter with parent's signature.
- 13) If any student remains absent for more than 3 days at a stretch without written permission /intimation his/her name will be struck off from the roll of the college.

- 14) Being in professional programme, all students are expected to maintain 90% attendance to help imbibing quality professionalism in them.
- 15) 90% physical attendance is compulsory to become eligible to write the University Semester Exam.
- 16) Attendance in Test examinations is mandatory. Absence from examination without valid reason would be treated as violation of college norms. The college authority may take strict action in this regard. Students will not be permitted to appear for an external exam without writing internal exams.
- 17) Any representation from class should be sent only through class representative with the approval from Class tutor and HOD.
- 18) The Class representative can meet the Principal during break or after 4.15 P.M on any working day.
- 19) Any irregularity will be initially referred to the Disciplinary Committee and the final decision will be taken as recommended by the committee with the approval of the Management.
- 20) Disobedience or misconduct will result in suspension of students and if any action of the accused is ascertained the management will not hesitate even to dismiss erroneous students.

- 21) Training and Placements priority will be given to students whose Personal file stands good and has no due on mess fees, special fees etc.
- 22) Conduct certificate will be issued with the following grades Excellent, Good, Fair, Satisfactory, Average- depending on the student's personal record.
- 23) Smoking is strictly prohibited in the campus.
- 24) Damaging the college property is punishable
- 25) Any infringement of the library rules will render the students privilege of admission to the library cancelled. Details of library rules are available with the librarian.
- 26) Students are required to take proper care of the College's property & keep the College premises neat & clean in order to inculcate right attitude towards the profession.

- 29) Please ensure that, in order to maintain discipline of the college, no one is allowed to get involved in outside activities.

- Students should not sit in the wall, verandah or play ground when Chairman's or Principal's car passes by.
- Students should stand still quiet in the same spot when Chairman's or Principal car passes by.
- Whistling or screaming inside or outside the classroom is strictly prohibited.
- 31) Grooming is an integral part of the hospitality industry. It is compulsory among students and they will not be allowed to take part in Practical's. Unless they are properly groomed, they will have to face the disciplinary action.

Boys

- Hair cut short, clean shaven, nail strimmed and clean uniform will be a good practice.
- Till uniforms are delivered, students should wear full sleeved formal shirt, formal trouser, plain black formal shoes with lace, black socks, necktie, and black belt with non–designer simple buckle.
- Avoid of using short shirts

Girls

- Girl students are expected to have their long hair neatly tied –up in a bun covered with net.
- No loose hair is permitted. Use of flashy excessive jewelry and strong scented perfume is not permitted.

LIBRARY RULES

- ❖ The Library is kept open from 8.30 am to 6.00 pm on all working days
- Strict silence should be observed in the library.
- One library token will be given to each student. Books will be issued to students only on the exchange of token.
- ❖ Loss of tokens, if any, should be immediately reported to the librarian who will issue duplicates on payment of Rs10.
- ❖ Books are usually lent for a period of 7 days. Books may be renewed for a further period if there is no demand for them from other students.
- Reference books such as dictionaries, encyclopedias, magazines and books will not be lent out.
- Students should not damage, write or make any mark on any magazine / book belonging to the library.
- ❖ If a borrowed book is lost or missed, the borrower should pay two times the cost of the book or replace the book.

- ❖ A Student on receiving a book must examine it for damage and report to the Librarian about the damage immediately, sub lending of books is forbidden
- ❖ Token is not transferable each student should bring his/ her identity card at the time of borrowing library books

- Students should return all books borrowed from the library one week before the last working day of the academic year/semester exams
- ❖ If books taken from the library are not returned within one week, the student would be asked to pay a fine of Rs 1 per day till the date of submission.

MONTHLY EXAMINATION ASSESMENT

For every semester three internal examinations will be held. Besides cyclic tests will also be conducted. Minimum pass in the internal exams are mandatory. The marks secured in all these examinations will be entered in the progress reports and the signature of the parents should be obtained on it at the parent teacher meet held periodically at the campus. If the progress or improvement is not satisfactory. We except the parent to meet either the Principal or the

Class Teacher periodically to get the academic status of their ward. Students must enlighten themselves with a greater knowledge by developing their study habits sincerely and aim to secure good marks in all examinations.






